esigned by the Giraffe Conservation
Foundation (GCF) in 2016, the Khomas
Environmental Education Programme
(KEEP) is an interactive field-based environmental
education programme that provides young
Namibian students and their teachers an
opportunity to explore nature first-hand and
learn about critical environmental issues and
sustainable practices just outside Namibia's
capital city Windhoek. The programme provides a
dynamic learning platform out of the classroom in
nature, and it aims to inspire young Namibians to
care for their environment and become stewards
of their country.

KEEP reconnects young Namibian with nature.

Aligned with the Namibian primary school curriculum, KEEP provides students a handson experience in topics that are otherwise only discussed in a classroom setting.

KEEP helps the transformation of young Namibians to responsible, critical thinkers, and problem-solvers and provides the necessary knowledge and skills to make environmentally responsible decisions that will safeguard our fragile environment in the future.

For more than eight years, GCF has successfully delivering this excellent and impactful environmental education programme to young Namibians, and it has become a firm part of the curriculum for many schools in the Khomas Region. In 2024, KEEP achieved a remarkable milestone by recording our highest number of annual participants so far and empowering some participating schools to implement environmental activities beyond our field programme.

In addition to our field programme, GCF also distributed over 15,000 copies of our GCF Nature Workbook, which is widely regarded as a valuable teaching resource, to schools throughout the country.






